The year I graduated from the University of Illinois (1980) Angela Davis was running for VPOTUS-Vice President of the United States. She ran on the Communist Party ticket. She was, and is active in opposing racial segregation, was a member of the Black Panthers, and continues to be agitator for far-left causes around the world. She even was honored by the East German Communists before the Berlin wall fell.

Her ideas are night and day different from mine.

But one thing she said has kind of piqued my interest. Determined to right the wrongs she sees Davis has turned the "Serenity Prayer" into a "Rallying Cry, *"I am no longer accepting the things I cannot change. I am changing the things I cannot accept."*

It's a great speech line, but if she had read the rest of the Prayer she would have read, *"Lord grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change, the courage to change the things I can change, and the Wisdom to know the difference."*

But I like her vision—The status quo has got to go! *...I'm no longer accepting...* things that I know to be wrong

And I like her zeal—*I'm changing...*

And I like her determination—*I'm changing what I cannot accept...*

Too often we languish in the slough of despond lamenting that things can never be different. Running for President in 1969 Robert Kennedy rephrased George Bernard Shaw, *"Some men see things as they are and say, why; I dream things that never were and say, why not."*

God is looking for visionaries who see things as they are and envision things as they ought to be. This is no time for God's people to retreat and relax, this will be our finest hour if we see ourselves as God sees us—Salt and Light!

God is looking for passionate, purpose-driven people who will do what ought to be done and do it zealously. Our Great Example zealously guarded the Temple, *"The House of Prayer for all nations."* As he purified the Temple court driving out the moneychangers his disciples remembered the Psalmist, *"the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up."* Indeed zeal is conviction in action.

God is looking for determined men and women. It has been rightly said that the measure of man is not how many times we are knocked down, rather how many times we get back up! (George Custer).

Think of Moses, David, Elijah, John Mark, among others in the Bible who failed spectacularly, but God blessed their determination to get up and get going again. We are determined to do the will of God and to advance the Kingdom of God!

But Angela's problem is not her lack of vision—it is her misfocused vision. It is not her lack of zeal—it is the misaffection of her zeal. It is not her determination—it is the misdirection of her determination.

All of which could be set right—in Angela and in me—if we could honestly, willingly and lovingly say that first word in the prayer—"LORD!"
